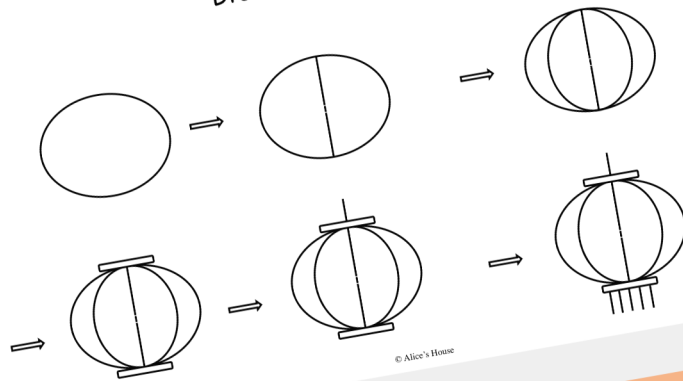

## Draw a Lantern

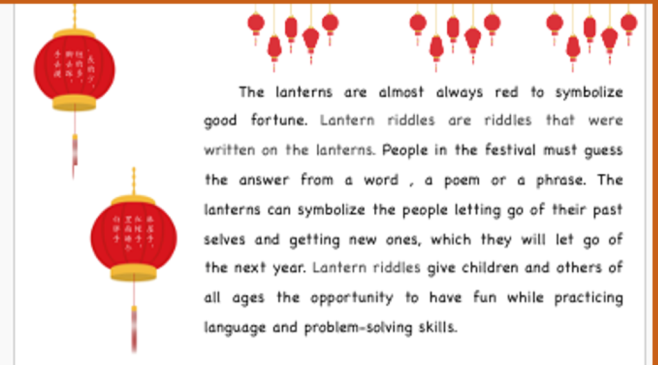

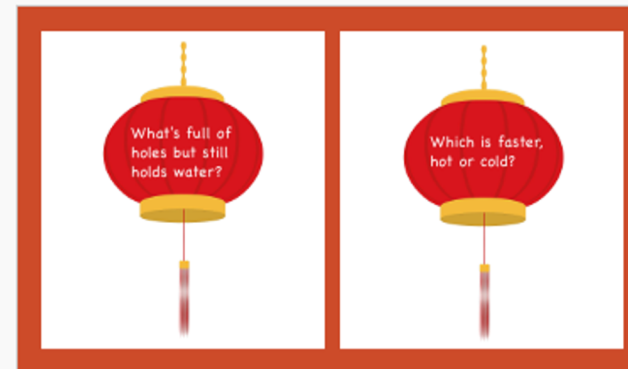
The Lantern Festival is a Chinese traditional festival celebrated on the full moon, the fifteenth day of the first month in the Chinese lunar calendar. It marks the final day of the traditional Chinese New Year celebrations.

During the Lantern Festival, people go out at night carrying paper lanterns and solve riddles on the lanterns.

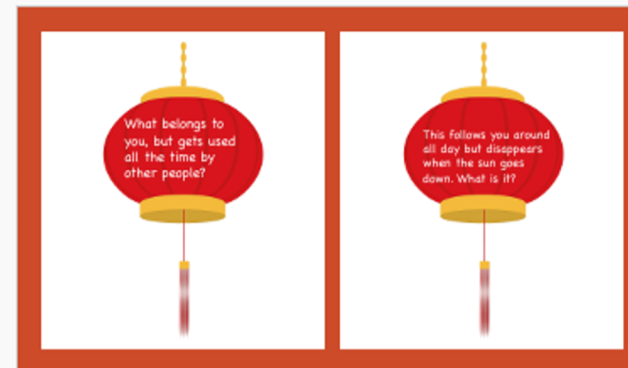


The lanterns are almost always red to symbolize good fortune. Lantern riddles are riddles that were written on the lanterns. People in the festival must guess the answer from a word, a poem or a phrase. The lanterns can symbolize the people letting go of their past selves and getting new ones, which they will let go of the next year. Lantern riddles give children and others of all ages the opportunity to have fun while practicing language and problem-solving skills.

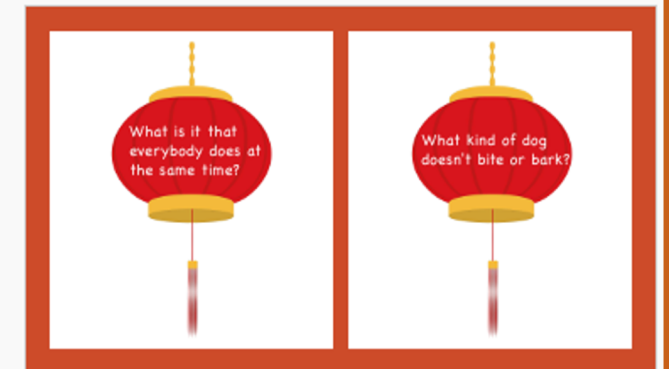
