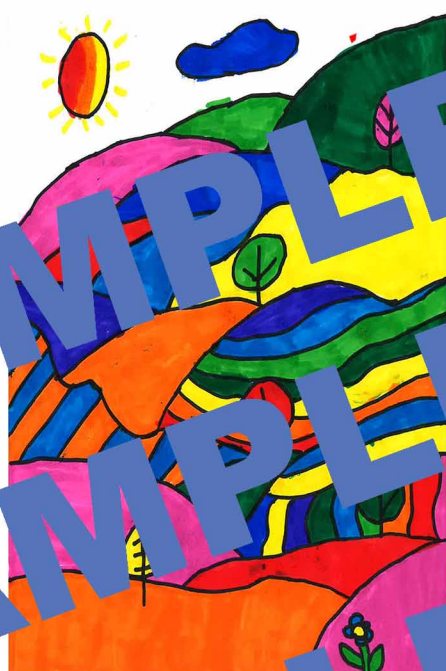
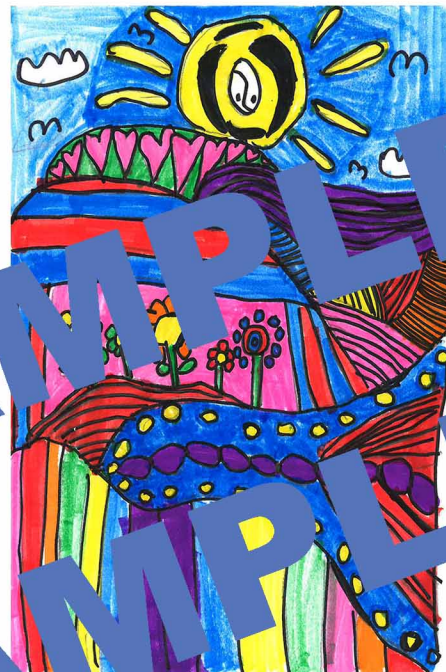

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Drawing Directions

Step 1: Display

- Show students the sample drawings.
- Remind students to use the sample drawings as a guide.
- Hills Drawing Directions:
 - Use the sample drawings as a guide.
 - Start with the hills.
 - Color the hills with warm colors (red, orange, yellow).
 - Add patterns to the hills.
 - Use a black Sharpie to draw the outlines of the hills.
 - Keep the drawing neat.
 - Draw the hills with a black Sharpie.

Step 2: Display

- Tell them to draw the hills with a black Sharpie.
- From the sample drawings, they can see the hills are drawn with a black Sharpie.

Step 3: Display

- Tell them to draw the hills with a black Sharpie.

Step 4: Trace the Picture with a Black Sharpie

- Pictures will always look sharp when drawn with a Sharpie.

Step 5: Color the Hills with Warm Colors

- Make sure you use warm colors (red, orange, yellow) to color the hills.
- Rolling hills are drawn with warm colors (red, orange, yellow) and added patterns for extra details (like trees, flowers, and clouds).
- Tree and flower patterns are drawn with a black Sharpie and colored in with warm colors (red, orange, yellow) and added patterns for extra details (like trees, flowers, and clouds).

Final Drawing Completion

- Have I colored inside the lines?
- Have I colored the whole picture without white spots?
- Have I colored all the hills using warm colors and added patterns or textures?
- Did I decorate the trees and flowers with bright, vivid colors?
- Have I traced all my pencil lines with a Sharpie?
- Have I tried my best to be creative?
- Did I try my best to make my rolling hills look like real hills?
- Have I write my name and number on the bottom of the drawing?
