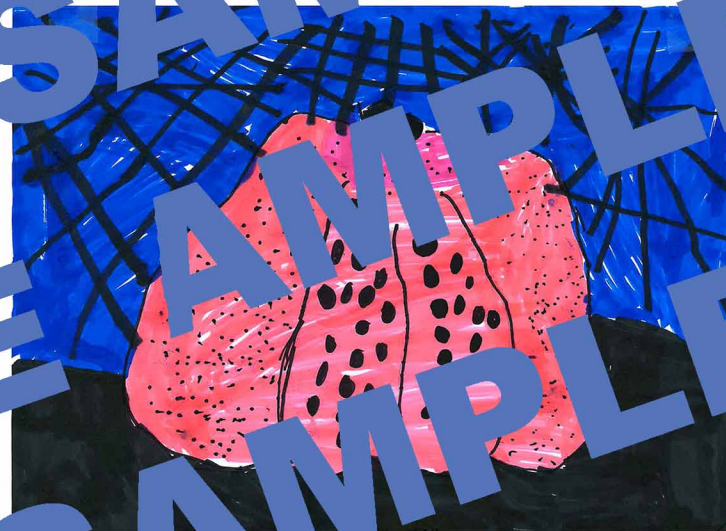
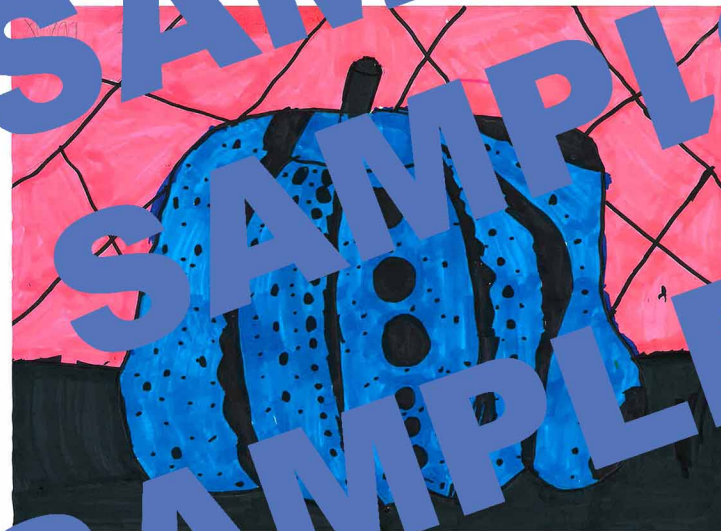
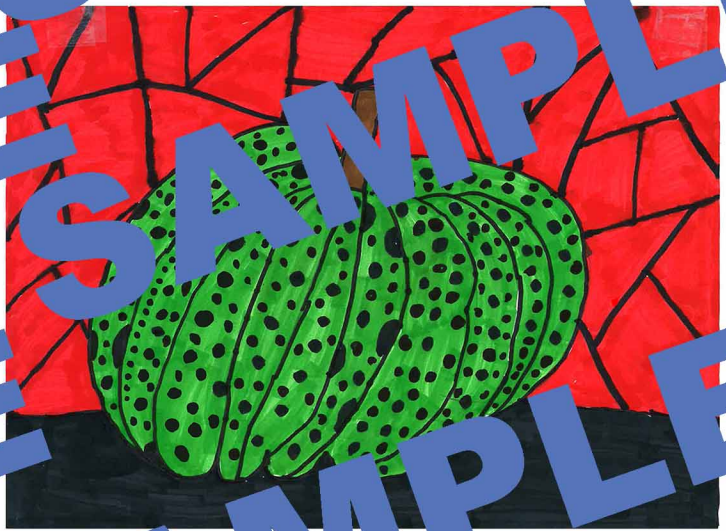
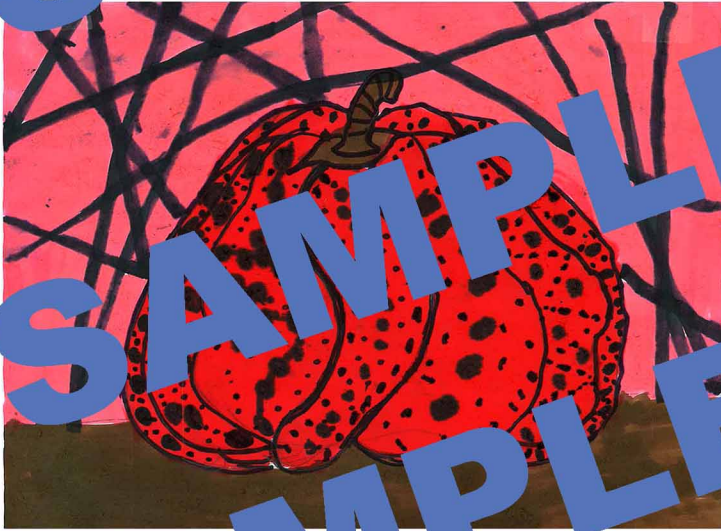
Dotted Pumpkin Drawing Lesson

Draw a dotted pumpkin to show color contrast on a central paper.

Drawing Instruction

- Step 1: Draw a pumpkin on the class.
- Display the drawing to look at.
 - Tell the class to draw a pumpkin only, sitting on a black table.
