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### Drawing Directions

#### Step 1: Display the Sample Drawings to the class.

- Show students example artworks for inspiration.
- Remind them: *Do not copy—create your own unique design!*
- Students will draw one Christmas boot in the back using colored pencils.
- **Boot Design**
  - Make sure the boot takes up most of the page.
  - The boot can have sole, heel, and top openings.
  - Optional: add a holly leaf at the top.
- **Add Decorations**
  - Add patterns, stripes, polka dots, etc.
  - Add small figures, bows, or candy canes.
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- **Background**
  - Keep it simple and clean.
  - Add small figures, bows, or candy canes.
- **Reason**
  - Draw gently falling snow or holly leaves scattered to give a festive feel.
  - Draw holly leaves, or ornaments.
  - It's perfectly OK if your castles sit right on add bushes, grass, or other decorations in

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#### Step 2: Picture with a Black Sharpie.

- Use a black sharpie to draw the outline of your boot. This will make your picture look bold and sharp.

#### Step 3: Color the Whole Picture with Markers.

- **Choose a Color Scheme:**
  - Stick to 2-3 main colors for the boot (e.g., red, green, and white) for a classic Christmas look.
  - Use complementary colors for decorations so they stand out.
- **Layer and Blend:**
  - Start with lighter shades and build up to darker colors for shading.
  - Blend colors together to create smooth gradients.
  - Use the back of the marker to blend colors like the boot body.
- **Use a Sharpie for Details:**
  - Use a sharpie to draw small details, like stars, snowflakes, or holly leaves.
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#### Step 4: Color the Sample

- Use the sample drawings as a guide for coloring. Pay attention to the colors and patterns used in the sample drawings.
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
