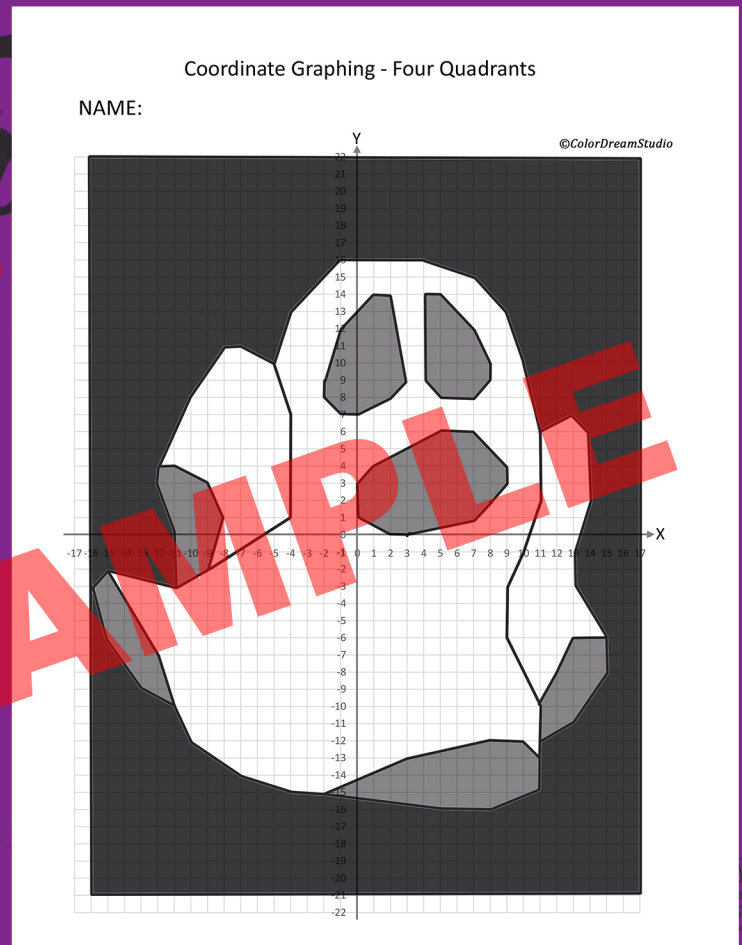


Coordinate Graphing
